Directions:

We're located at mile 7.6 on the Talkeetna Spur Road, about 6 miles from downtown Talkeetna.

By Air:

Most people fly into Anchorage International Airport and pick up a rental car.

You can fly into Talkeetna by small plane. Adjacent to AIA is Lake Hood, one of the world's largest float plane airports. Private planes can land at Talkeetna regional airport (6 miles) or K-2's float plane base is less than a half mile away. Call us for a ride.

By Train:

The train is one of the best ways to see central Alaska.

The main Alaska Railroad station is located just north of Anchorage's downtown area. Talkeetna is one of three stops on the Alaska Railroad between Fairbanks and Anchorage, with trains both northbound and southbound daily during the summer.

By Shuttle:

There is daily shuttle bus service from Anchorage to Talkeetna in summer.

By Car:

Head north from Anchorage on the Glenn Highway (Hwy 1).

Where the roads split, take the Parks Highway (Hwy 3) to Wasilla. Pick up anything you need in Wasilla- it's the last city (last supermarket for 300+ miles!)

Follow the Parks Highway to Mile 99, then turn right onto the Talkeetna Spur Road.

There are no street addresses in rural AK - everyone uses mile markers as reference points (watch for the green markers along the highway).

Construction along the Spur Road may make it hard to see the markers, so check your odometer when you make the turn onto the Spur Rd.

We're located at mile 7.6, on the west side of the highway. After mile 7, as you come up the hill, on the right you should see a lake (Question Lake), then Barge Road, and then the Assembly of God Church.

We're the second driveway on the left after the church. Our log cabin is visible from the road.

Turn just before the highway sign for Paradise Cabins. (If you get to Birch Creek Road, you've gone too far. Turn around, and try again. Heading south, turn right immediately after the 55 mph sign.)
